Saddle Hill Foundation Trust (SHFT) was established by East Taieri Church in 1994 to resource and oversee our community and youth work. SHFT maintains a close relationship with ET Church through representation on the SHFT board, shared vision and values, staff working together as a team, and through service contracts. Over recent years SHFT has grown significantly and now serves the Saddle Hill communities through three strands: social enterprise (Shop on Taieri), community and youth. The SHFT board have been refining their structure, job roles and reporting lines and have identified the need for an executive officer to manage and lead these three strands. We are pleased to announce that Andy Doncaster has been appointed to this role. Andy was to start next week as SHFT's new youth director, but the restructuring work proceeded faster than planned and Andy has community and social enterprise experience so we interviewed him for that larger role. He will retain a strong youth focus as executive officer, but also have wider responsibilities. Please pray for all involved as we transition to this new structure. We are hopeful that this restructuring will enable SHFT to access new levels of funding and better express the love of Jesus Christ in our communities. Please also pray for Andy, his wife Ashley and their two boys Kyle (15) and Keegan (13) as they settle into life, work and school on the Taieri.
